Upwards of 500 NYAPRS self and system advocates braved the bitter cold and came to Albany last Tuesday to speak out in very personal items about the urgent need for sustainable and humane services and supports for our community.

We marched around the Capital, did media interviews and met with state legislators and staff throughout the day, pressing for increased housing rates, a cost of living adjustment for our dedicated workforce and a permanent ban on the use of solitary confinement with people with mental health conditions.

- Sending 15 buses from across New York to Albany cost \$25,000.
