Timothy's Law would end the discrimination in health insurance policies by requiring companies to provide coverage for mental health and chemical dependency treatment. The bill is named after Timothy O'Clar who completed suicide at the age of 12. His parents had struggled for years trying to obtain adequate mental health treatment for their son.
